Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them.

For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: (KJV)Ro 1:19-20

For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul. (KJV)Lev 17:11

But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. (KJV)1Co 2:14

God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

The spirit of man is the candle of the LORD, searching all the inward parts of the belly.

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles. (KJV)Isa 42:1

No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen. (KJV)Ex 33:20; Jn 1:18; 1Ti 6:16

But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.

And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words.

And it shall come to pass, while my glory passeth by, that I will put thee in a cliff of the rock, and will cover thee with my hand while I pass by: (KJV)Ex 33:21-22

Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar:

And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged. (KJV)Isa 6:1, 5-7

And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: (KJV)Heb 9:22; Ro 6:23; IPe 1:18-19

The LORD hath sworn in truth unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.

Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell? (KJV)Ps 132:11; Pr 30:4

Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man? And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. (KJV)Lk 1:34-35

For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (KJV)2Co 5:21

Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. (KJV)Mt 5:17

Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.

Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself. (KJV)Lk 24:7; Php 3:21

And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. (KJV)Eph 4:30

Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men. (KJV)Mt 12:31

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. (KJV)Jn 14:6, 14

If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him? (KJV)Lk 11:13

Invitation to the kingdom

1. You need to be saved:

2. You cannot save yourself: Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us... (KJV) Titus 3:5

3. Jesus has provided for your salvation: But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (KJV) Ro 5:8

4. You must accept Jesus for salvation: ... Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved...
That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. (KJV) Acts 16:31; Ro 10:9-10

5. Now is the time to accept Jesus as savior: ... behold, now is the day of salvation.
